Service Dog or Therapy Dog?

As you may have noticed, there are people who are using their dogs for THEIR emotional support. We train our dogs as therapy dogs to offer emotional support to OTHERS in nursing homes, hospitals, etc. to make people feel better. This is a good time to educate and let people know what our dogs do for everyone.

Over the years dogs have been trained as service dogs to assist people with disabilities - diabetics, narcolepsy, autism, wheelchair assist, hearing impaired, guide dogs for the blind. People pay a very high price for a well-trained dog with prices ranging from \$30,000 - \$50,000. Some owners do their own private training and work and learn together.

A business can ask "Is your dog a service animal?" If the owner says "yes" then they can ask, "What task does that dog do for you". Then the owner has to give a specific task. They cannot ask your diagnosis but you must answer that question. It is a federal law. Answering that the dog provides emotional support does not qualify it as a service dog, meaning it cannot legally enter any public venue. Dogs that accompany you everywhere and make you feel better by its presence is a pet not a service dog under the law.

A "service dog" must be "in control" and "housebroken" if out in public. Business owners can ask the owner to leave if the dog is misbehaving.

There is a trend that is causing a problem now since psychologists and psychiatrists are writing prescriptions for emotional support dogs and owners think that means they can take it anywhere, including on airplanes. They still have to be trained and people will say "This is my emotional support dog" and all the business owners are afraid they will get sued by the Justice Dept. if they don't let them in. That's not true.

If anyone needs to check out these rules you can Google it and read how to keep out untrained Emotional Support Dogs. It's really that simple.
