"Tone and Volume is not what we say but how we say it."

If your tone reflects pleasure, love, sadness, disappointment or worry, your dog will pick up on it. Dogs respond to different volumes. If you speak at a regular volume and suddenly shout, he will know something is up and pay attention. Your dog detects total change from happy to demanding or sad or cheerful.

There are five common distinguishing tones in dog

training:

Cheerful - (high volume, high pitch) he will perk his ears and wag his tail - Good Dog!

Disappointed - (low volume, low pitch) it commands attention, accompanied by a frown. He will lower his head and tail.

Soft and reassuring - (low volume, high pitch) it expresses affection and caring, tells him you love him.

Firm - (low volume, low pitch) commands attention and he better listen.

Caution - (high volume and high or low pitch) a sudden commando get your dogs immediate attention. Used in emergencies. If overused, it loses its effect (using a short sound that is used only for emergencies may work since it is quick and effective).

Vocal is important even if you'd dog does not see you. Calling him to come into the house.

Dogs also recognize actual words: "Treat", "Potty", "Down", "Sit", etc. You always should use a release word such as "OK". Try to not use the dog's name and say it one time.

Canine communication uses most of the senses including smell, sounds, visual cues. Pheromones, glandular secretions, barks, whines, growls, body posture. Unlike in people, canine body posture and scent cues are significant components of dog language.
