From time to time I receive calls from people trying to rent and they have dogs. Renters are reluctant to have dogs as tenants in their facilities. By familiarizing you with some suggestions it may help you or someone you know in how to prepare your dog to find a dog friendly landlord.

First, you should train your dog to have good manners and have it pass the Good Citizen Test. This certificate also is your ticket to a summer vacation and traveling in trying to find a motel that will accept pets. Believe it or not that surpasses Therapy Dog since they are more familiar with the CGC. As a note those driving in New Jersey are required to have their dogs in a seat belt or crate. You can be fined by not complying.

Second, keep your dog up-dated with flea prevention treatment.

Third, have your dog current on his shots and always keep his records copied and on hand for examination.

Fourth, references from former landlords, pet sitters, veterinarians, and trainers who can attest to your dog's good behavior and health.

You will probably be asked for a pet deposit and in some cases an extra "pet rent" fee added to your monthly rent for keeping a dog or cat.

There are always people who are discourteous and some who do not clean up after their dogs who ruin it for everyone else. As a rightful pet owner, we must set a good example with our dogs and also educate those who may try to abuse privileges which make it difficult for the well-mannered dog.

One example is the pet bag policy at the Shikellamy Marina, which was established by Dixie years ago. The park was about to shut down pets from being walked there, and he placed stations to be used by pet walkers for clean up. Now it is a wonderful place to walk and socialize your dog. Thanks to Giant who donates bags for me to place there.
