There is an organization T.A.G.S. (Train, Assist, Guide, Serve), an all-volunteer organization, that helps veterans train their personal pets to pass the public access test required for service dogs in PA.

This new mission has given the former soldiers a new confidence to enter public places and handle crowds through carefully-honed teamwork with their pets. These dog teams are made up of Poodles, Springer Spaniels, terrier mixes not typically as-

sociated with service dog work, but these, after all, are family pets. Many have been rescued.

These former soldiers have been clinically diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorders by the Veterans Administration and were referred by them to the T.A.G.S. program. These soldier-and-dog teams are identified by the camouflage service-dog vests made from the owner's original fatigues.

The group has been training at Obedience Training Class of Harrisburg, and the difference these dogs have made in these veteran's lives is amazing. The focus is off of them and on the dog. Many Veterans are being treated at VA Hospitals for PTSD and working with a dog as a companion animal has brought many rewards to them and helped their families

These dog teams can be seen on field trips training in stores and on elevators. Since these individuals look fine and healthy there is some confusion and the participants have been confronted in stores and elsewhere questioning their authenticity. Some of these folks are recovering from brain injuries and PTSD, and most cannot afford a pre-trained service animal that can cost thousands of dollars.
