When the newness of a puppy wears off, we may wonder, how long will it take to help the pup fit into family life?

From birth a pup is learning, through touch and scents, even though it does not see or hear and going to the next step of socialization and experiencing multiple stimuli which it should look forward to.

Factors that influence learning are: maternal care and stress level during pregnancy, good puppy nutrition, genetic predisposition, learning style and training technique. A mother's stress level can affect future

behavior in her pups making them more anxious or fearful and they can benefit from additional socialization.

Feeding high quality food containing dish oil, has shown to improve learning ability I puppies and may have stronger responses to training.

There are different types of learners in the breed: herding have a reputation as fast learners; hounds and guardian dogs may seem to not have caught on but they are watching and thinking; independent dogs have good problem-solving skills which makes it difficult to stay ahead of them.

In training it is not unusual for dogs to mimic when they see other dogs, especially if they are being rewarded for behavior.

How long does it take to learn basic cues? "It Depends" - dogs learn more quickly with practice and patience; build on you and your dog's successes. No matter when your dog achieves maturity, learning is a life-long endeavor. Continuing to practice a dog's skills and teach new ones through life, (tricks) even into old age, it helps to keep their brains supple and may help to starve off dementia.

Getting together each week at a class and socializing our dogs keeps them well-socialized and trained for many situations. As a Club and working with our members it gives all of us something too look forward to and make it a "learning experience" for me which I enjoy.


